Submission of your application authorizes our scholarship review committee to consider you for all the scholarships that we may award. If you would like to also be considered for the Agricultural Employee Family Scholarship, please include documentation supporting your family's connection to an agriculture-related employer.

Topa Topa Flywheelers Scholarship \$1000

Topa Topa Flywheelers is a group of people of all ages and professions who have dedicated their time and efforts to the collection, restoration and operation of machinery and implements as used in agriculture in by-gone days. The primary purpose of the club is to collect, preserve, restore, display, show, and operate antique farm equipment and machinery. Their second objective is to educate the public regarding how this equipment was used in the past and for what purpose.

General CWA Scholarship \$1000

The general CWA Scholarship award will be given to a deserving student who we think has potential to be successful in a career in agriculture or a related field.

Agricultural Employee Family Scholarship \$1000

The Agriculture Employee's Family scholarship will be given to a student whose parent/guardian has been employed in Ventura County agriculture for the past two (2) years. (farm labor, work for an Ag-related industry such as chemical company, packing house, well drilling, etc.)

Carolyn Leavens Memorial Scholarship \$1000

Carolyn Leavens (1930-2011) was a guiding light for agriculture and education in Ventura County. As a 4th generation farmer in our county, her roots in agriculture were well established. She was a founding member of the Ventura County Chapter of CWA and CWA State President in 1981. Carolyn also played important roles in American Agri-Women including AAW president from 1983-1985. She received several prestigious awards including California Legislature Woman of the Year in 1988. Carolyn Leavens also had a key role in bringing CSU Channel Islands University to Ventura County. We name this scholarship in her memory to recognize and appreciate her dedication and hard work on behalf of agriculture and education in Ventura County.



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APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must complete and sign the 3-page application.
- Applicant must have a cumulative high school or college grade point average of 2.8 or higher.
- Applicant must provide an official transcript of grades from current school
- Statement of Educational Purpose:

Applicant must submit a 1-page essay about yourself telling us why you are a deserving candidate for this scholarship. Please tell us about your background, your current achievements, and your education dreams and goals.

- Applicant must provide a list of extra-curricular school activities, community service, church participation, and other accomplishments you would like to share with us. Include any awards you have received.
- Applicant must provide two letters of recommendation from a non- family member.
- High school seniors and college students are eligible to apply.
- Past recipients are eligible to re-apply.
