Funds received through the VC-CWA Livestock Award can be used to offset the cost of equipment, show supplies, show uniform, feed, or the cost of the animal(s).

- **Large Livestock Projects**
 - **\$750** – Market Steer **OR** Breeding Heifer
 - **\$500** – Market Lamb, Market Swine, Market Goats **OR** Breeding Ewe/Ram
- **Small Livestock Project**
 - **\$200** – Pen of Market Rabbits

** In light of the current situation regarding CA H5N1 Avian Influenza (as of February 15, 2025), VC-CWA will not be accepting applications for any market poultry projects for the 2025 year. We hope for a swift resolution and look forward to reinstating these categories for the 2026 application cycle.*

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a Ventura County resident (Caprinteria FFA students eligible).
- Must be a 4-H, FFA, Grange or Independent youth livestock exhibitor aged 9-18 exhibiting at the 2025 Ventura County Fair.
- Must be a member in good standing of their respective organization.
- Must show dedication to furthering the progress of agriculture or an associated field.
- Financial need may be taken into consideration, but is not required.

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION:

- Applications must be emailed by **May 1, 2025**.

Please create a video featuring yourself and your project animal that is at least one minute in length and includes the topics below, along with anything else you'd like to share with the selection committee:

- Your name.
- The name of the club/group/chapter that you are a member of.
- How long you've been a member of your club/chapter/group and how long you have been showing livestock?
- The breed and species of livestock you are exhibiting.
- What are you doing to prepare for the fair?
- What are you most looking forward to when exhibiting at the fair?
- What is the most interesting thing you've learned about your project?
- How would receiving this grant make a difference for you and your family while raising this project?

ESSAY PROMPT

The VC-CWA Livestock Award recognizes young agricultural leaders who demonstrate dedication, responsibility, and a passion for raising and exhibiting livestock. In a well-organized essay, explain why you deserve this award.

Consider discussing:

- Your experience raising and caring for livestock, including challenges you have overcome.
- The skills and life lessons you have gained through your livestock project.
- How participating in livestock exhibitions has shaped your character, work ethic, and future goals.
- The impact of agriculture on your life and how you plan to contribute to the industry.
- How receiving this award would support your growth and future aspirations in agriculture.
- If you and your family are facing financial hardships, please elaborate on that if you feel comfortable.

Within your essay, please make sure to include which club/chapter/group you are affiliated with, how long you've been a member, and the breed and species you will be exhibiting.
