- Financial need may be taken into consideration, but is not required.

SUPPORTING MATERIALS:

Applicants must provide the following materials along with a completed VC-CWA scholarship application:

- An official copy of the applicant's current high school, college or trade school transcript.
- Two letters of recommendation from two non-family members.
- A copy of the applicant's resume with school, community or church activities and any awards, honors or scholarships received.
- One essay (500 words maximum), double spaced, typed in Times New Roman, 12-point font.
