Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 GPA on a scale of 4.0. Priority will be given to students who are the first generation in their families to pursue studies beyond high school.

Eligibility Requirements for all Scholarships:

Please review the specific scholarship you are applying for about any additional requirements.

- Must be a Ventura County resident (*Current college or continuing education students who graduated from a Ventura County high school may still apply*).
- Must be enrolled or planning to enroll in an accredited university, junior college, or trade school program related to agriculture.
- Must show dedication to furthering the progress of agriculture or an associated field.
- Must be under the age of 25.
- Financial need may be taken into consideration, but is not required.

Essay:

Please submit an essay that is 500 words or more, double-spaced, using Times New Roman, 12-point font.

- **ESSAY PROMPT:** This scholarship supports Ventura County students who are passionate about agriculture and dedicated to its future. In a well-organized essay, explain your connection to agriculture, your experiences in the industry, and how you plan to contribute to its growth and sustainability.
 - Consider discussing:
 - Your background and involvement in agriculture, including any hands-on experience, leadership roles, or community engagement.
 - Challenges facing the agriculture industry and how you hope to address them.
 - How your education and career goals align with supporting and advancing agriculture in Ventura County.
 - The impact agriculture has had on your life and why it is important to you.
 - How this scholarship will help you achieve your goals in the agricultural field.
 - If you and your family are facing financial hardships, please elaborate on that if you feel comfortable.

Supporting Materials:

Alongside the essay, applicants must provide the following materials:

- A completed VC-CWA scholarship application.
- An official or unofficial copy of the applicant's current high school, college or trade school transcript.
- Two letters of recommendation from two non-family members.
- A copy of the applicant's resume with school, community or church activities and any awards, honors or scholarships received.
